



AN AQUAMARINE ARRANGEMENT

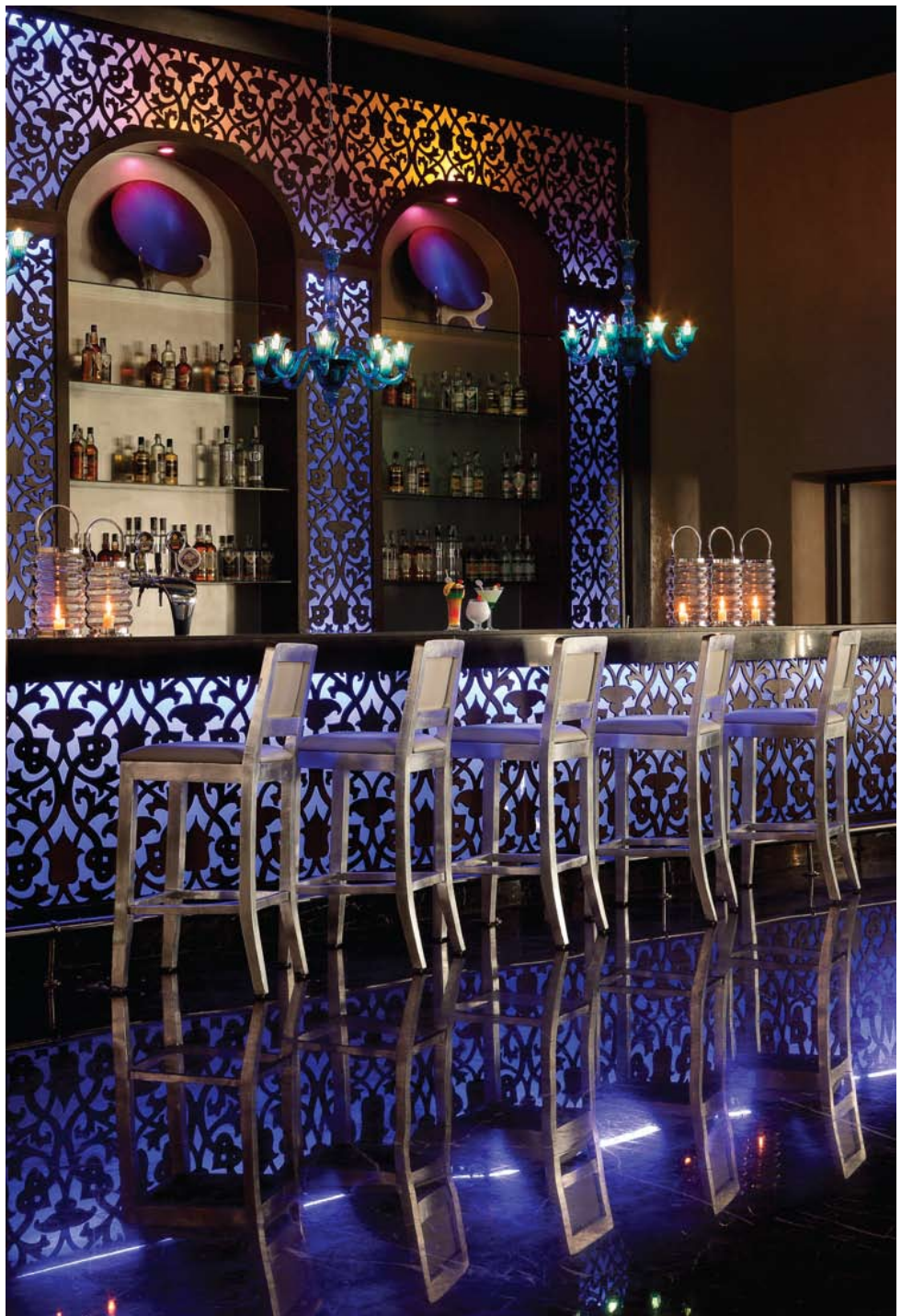

But for relaxation, you need a sanctuary. To create this sanctuary, designer Dora Chiaty created the ultimate hub for well-deserved rest and relaxation, the Iberotel Aquamarine Hurghada. The interior design is a stunning display of the stylistic stunts making the Iberotel Aquamarine a truly Egyptian holiday getaway.



The reception adapts the same universal design typology used throughout the hotel's interiors using only pearly whites. The ceiling above is supported by wide arches which goes along with the same style used in throughout the lobby and the bar.



Taking a step inside the hotel is not just about feeling the cool air but the cool atmosphere. The Iberotel Aquamarine's lobby bar freezes the atmosphere using a lighting mixture of light blues. The bar is designed with ornate motifs similar to that seen in Islamic monuments.



Taking a step deeper into this aquamarine dream, the viewer is almost electrified by the combination of light blues on the walls and pearly whites of the marble. The second lobby weaves itself into a consistent message which echoes throughout the hotel's interiors.
